

InfoClique is a web-based system designed to provide the medical staff of Kaleida Health and referring physician offices a secure central access point for patient information.

System Features

Patient information available online includes:

Patient Census:

A listing of your patients as an attending, consulting, or referring physician by location.

Demographics:

Basic patient information, such as name and address, insurance, religion, date of birth, gender, social security number, guarantor, and emergency information. Visit-specific information such as physicians and chief complaint.

Patient Flow:

Find out how and where the patient is within a Kaleida Health facility.

Dictated Reports:

Medical transcriptions such as H&Ps, operative reports, discharge summaries, and consultation.

Orders:

All issued orders and status for both in- and out-patients, such as ECG/EKG, nursing care level, echos, labs, and more.

Results:

Results of orders, such as radiology, cardiology, endoscopy, and general laboratory results containing procedure, units, ref, range values over a specified time range, and scanned images.

Medications:

Medication administration list (MALs) containing scheduled, PRN, and historical drug orders.

Surgery Schedules:

Review past and future surgery schedules. Print version available.

ED Scanned Documents:

BGH and Suburban Emergency Department documents are now accessible.

Tracemaster ECGs:

ECG strips are available to those users on the Kaleida Health network.

- Print a hospital visit list sorted by location upon your arrival.
- Connect to a spectrum of Kaleida Medical Staff related information.
